Entry application must be turned in no later than **Friday, March 6, 2020** and will **not** be accepted after that date. All applications are subject to review and approval by the Parade Committee.

The Parade will start promptly at **2:00 PM on Sunday, March 15, 2020.**

We request that each parade entry arrive at the parade line up area at **12:30 PM** the day of the parade.

Unit numbers 1-30 will line up along the North side of Center Avenue from Park going back to Livingston.

Unit numbers 31-60 will line up along the South side of Center Avenue from Park going back to Livingston.

Unit numbers 61-90 will line up along the West side of Livingston from Center Avenue back.

Unit numbers 90 to the end will line up from Center Avenue back towards Scheurmann on the North side of Center.

THE CENTER LANE ON CENTER AVENUE IS TO REMAIN OPEN FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES AND THE REARRANGING OF PARADE ENTRIES.

1. To qualify as a float, an entry must be skirted, and all objects on it must be completely decorated in good taste. Please, **No** signs stating prices of goods or services offered by business entry on float.
2. Floats must not exceed 20 feet in length and 12.5 feet in height. Exceptions to the rule must be approved by the Parade Committee. Please call AI at 686-6834.
3. Lettering must be at least 6 inches in height, unless a company logo is incorporated in the design of the float.
4. **Music or sound** used on a float **must be stated on the application.**
5. **ONLY CURRENT OFFICE HOLDERS MAY ENTER PARADE.** This is a non-political event and political candidates running for any office may **NOT** enter the parade. **NO exceptions.**
6. Horse units and antique cars will be permitted. Only cars 30 years or older will be considered antique. Horse units must provide "pooper scooper" and keep the streets clean.
7. **NO INTOXICATING BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PARADE OR LINE UP AREA.**
8. The Bay City Public Safety Department will have the authority to act as they see fit to insure safety for parade visitors and participants.



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9. **NO objects may be tossed or thrown from floats or vehicles. Candy may be HANDED out by walkers alongside the entry.** Entry must keep moving along parade route and not stop.
10. All material must be flame retardant.
11. This is a family event. All parade entries are asked to decorate their floats or vehicles that reflect the current parade theme. Parade floats or vehicles as well as parade participants must be decorated/dressed in good taste with no inappropriate signs, clothing, or decorations. If you do, you will be removed from the parade by police at parade committee request. Violators will be put on probation and returning to the parade will be only with parade committee approval.
12. Trophies awarded for: Best Irish theme, Presidents Trophy, and Best Overall
13. All floats are encouraged to decorate with an Irish theme. Deviation from the above rules will be made at the sole discretion of the Parade Committee. **Entries that do not follow the rules may NOT be invited to return for the next parade year.**
14. Parade Judges will determine parade trophy winners during the parade. Winners will be contacted and invited to an Award Ceremony held after the parade. Check our Facebook and website for time and location. Please be sure to attend!
